Concealed Weapons

- The Texas Concealed Handgun License (CHL) prohibits carrying concealed firearms in federal buildings and federal property
- The Texas Castle Law does not apply on Fort Hood because of the exclusive federal jurisdictions
 - Owners of firearms registered on Fort Hood are authorized to transport them in their vehicle as long as they follow the Fort Hood regulations for transportation of firearms
 - They may not carry firearms concealed on their person
 - Owners of firearms registered on Fort Hood are authorized to store firearms in their government housing

Speeding

The current focus of police speed enforcement is on areas with high population densities (i.e., troop crossings, school zones and housing areas and intersections with the highest number of traffic accidents. DES also conducts random speed enforcement on range roads.

Effective Tuesday, September 1, 2015, the installation access processes changed as follows:

- All Soldiers, Family Members, DoD Civilians, Retirees and any other DoD identification card holder will show their DoD ID at the gate for entrance to the installation. Passengers (with proper ID) can be escorted onto the installation.
- Customers who routinely access Fort Hood can get an extended access pass at the visitor center, i.e. contractors, school teachers, bank workers, but will not be able to escort other visitors. These customers can get a bulk issue of passes for their employees. Business owners or management staff will submit a memo to DES with employee(s) name(s), date of birth, driver's license number/State ID and last 4 of social security number.
- All non-DoD drivers and passengers are required to report to the Visitors Welcome Center to obtain an installation access pass. Children under 17 years of age may be vouched for by an adult.
- The Visitors Welcome Center is open 24 hours per day.
- There is no change to the firearms registration program. All firearms must be registered prior to transporting onto Fort Hood. Firearms registration can be completed at the Visitors Welcome Center or the Military Police station on 58th and Battalion Avenue.

Fort Hood is nearing the beginning of the 2015 - 2016 winter season. The Greater Fort Hood area is subject to severe winter weather, including snow, sleet and freezing rain through April.

Fort Hood has an established and proven procedure to determine and announce the Installation's Operational Status of Open, Closed, Open under Delayed Reporting or Open with Early Dismissal. Multiple media venues, both on and off post, are used to inform the Greater Fort Hood Community of changes to the Installation's Operational Status.

Killeen Independent School District (KISD) with its nine schools on Fort Hood (2 middle and 7 elementary) works closely with Fort Hood when schools are impacted by winter weather.

Did You Know...

...AER has provided more than 17,000 Wounded Warrior grants? In 2003, AER identified a critical need for our Wounded Warriors. When our Soldiers were medically evacuated from theater, many were transported out of the theater of operations with just the clothes on their back, without cash or credit cards. AER stepped in and developed a system which provided our Wounded Warriors immediate assistance. Today, every Wounded Warrior medically evacuated from a theater of combat for inpatient care is provided a \$500 comfort grant. This grant has no restrictions. It is intended for the purchase of anything that could make a Soldier's recovery more comfortable, while minimizing the concern for immediate cash needs.

...Army Emergency Relief was established at the beginning of World War II to meet the unmet need to provide emergency financial assistance to Soldiers? AER relies on donations resulting from the annual awareness campaign. During the annual campaign, Active Duty and Retired Soldiers are reminded of AER benefits, as well as given an opportunity to help take care of their fellow Soldiers. Despite an unstable economy, the 2014 campaign generated \$8.4 million in donations. Consider this: If EVERY Active Duty Soldier donated just \$5 per month, AER would have more than \$29 million to respond to your needs!

Although it is a medical diagnosis, Tri-Care will only cover the very expensive helmets if there is surgery involved.
