Survivors Post Decal is here



The Department of the Army has developed and is implementing a Vehicle Identification Decal which is provided to you with the utmost gratitude for your sacrifice and that of your loved one who died in the service of our Nation. If you do not have a Department of Defense identification card, the use of this decal should make it much easier to gain entrance to Army installations by eliminating the requirement to obtain a visitor/temporary vehicle pass whenever you come on post. Fort Hood is ready to start issuing the Survivor decals now. You will need to come in person to the SOS office located in building 10043 Battalion Ave, Fort Hood, Texas to complete the Survivor decal application. Once the application has been filled out and signed by a SOS staff member, you can take the documents to the Marvin Leath Visitor center. You will need:

- Valid Driver's license
- Copy of current insurance
- Copy of current vehicle registration receipt
- Sign copy of the SOS decal application

Upon entering the Visitor center you will proceed to lane #7 for assistance. Survivor Family members are authorized "front of the line privileges". The decal will be affixed to the inside of the vehicle windshield in the top center. Recipients will be instructed that if the decal becomes unreadable or damaged or if the recipient sells, trades or otherwise no longer owns the vehicle, the decal will need to be removed and returned to the issuing facility.
